INCLUSION MODEL (The Goal)

$A + A + A + A = \text{Integrated Community}$

Acceptance: The Welcome (Seat at table)

Acknowledgment: The Voice (Being heard)

Action: Engagement (Tangible change)

Accountability: Navigation (Systems)

EXCLUSION MODEL (The Trap)

Ignorance | Inaction | Rejection | Apathy

6 Partial States: Observer, Token, Issue, Interaction, Invitation, Intervention

👤 CRITICAL TALKING POINTS

- Slide 2 (Rules):** "Motivating discomfort." Focus on systems, not individuals.
- Slide 3 (Stats):** Pause. Let the 40% vs 1.6% gap sink in.
- Slide 4 (Shift):** Bias is neutral terrain. Inclusion is the mapped course.
- Slide 12 (Video):** "Hairless Town" analogy. Majority vs Outsider.
- Slide 14 (Jesus):** He consistently smashed barriers. It's Kingdom DNA.
- Slide 17 (Activity):** 10 mins for group work. Identify Dead End -> Find Path.
- Slide 27 (Commitment):** "One coordinate." Say it out loud (65% increase).



❖ 5 SCENARIOS (QUICK LIST)

- Resume Rejected**
→ Solution: Blind resumes, objective criteria.
- Chaperone Forced**
→ Solution: Trust clergy, offer choice.
- Board Member Pigeonholed**
→ Solution: Match gifting, rotate roles.
- Family Question (Interview)**
→ Solution: Standardize questions (legal/ethical).
- Troubled Church Trap**
→ Solution: Objective placement criteria for all sizes.



⚠ TIME SAVERS & RESCUE PLANS

Running Behind?

CUT the large group share-back (Slides 18-22).

Just show the "Path Forward" points quickly.

Running Ahead?

EXPAND the "One Commitment" discussion.

Ask 3-4 people to share.

Video Fails?

Verbally explain: "Imagine a town where everyone is bald. An outsider with hair arrives..."

Resistant Participant?

Redirect: "We are analyzing the system here, not condemning individuals."

Remember: Inclusion is a recurring commute, not a destination. You are the GPS today.
